A LOCAL LAW

To amend the administrative code of the city of New York, to repeal section 28-103.22 of the administrative code of the city of New York relating to outreach on security grille visibility requirements, items 5 and 5.1 of section 28-201.2.2 of the administrative code relating to penalties for non-conforming security grilles, section 28-315.7.1 of the administrative code of the city of New York relating to the retroactive application of security grille requirements, and items 3 and 4 of section 1010.1.4.4 of the New York city building code

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Sections 28-103.22 and 28-315.7.1 of the administrative code of the city of New York are REPEALED.

§ 2. Items 5 and 5.1 of section 28-201.2.2 of the administrative code of the city of New York are REPEALED, item 6 of such section is redesignated item 5, and item 7 of such section is redesignated item 6.

§ 3. Items 3 and 4 of section 1010.1.4.4 of the New York city building code are REPEALED and item 5 of such section is redesignated item 3.

§ 4. This local law takes effect immediately.
